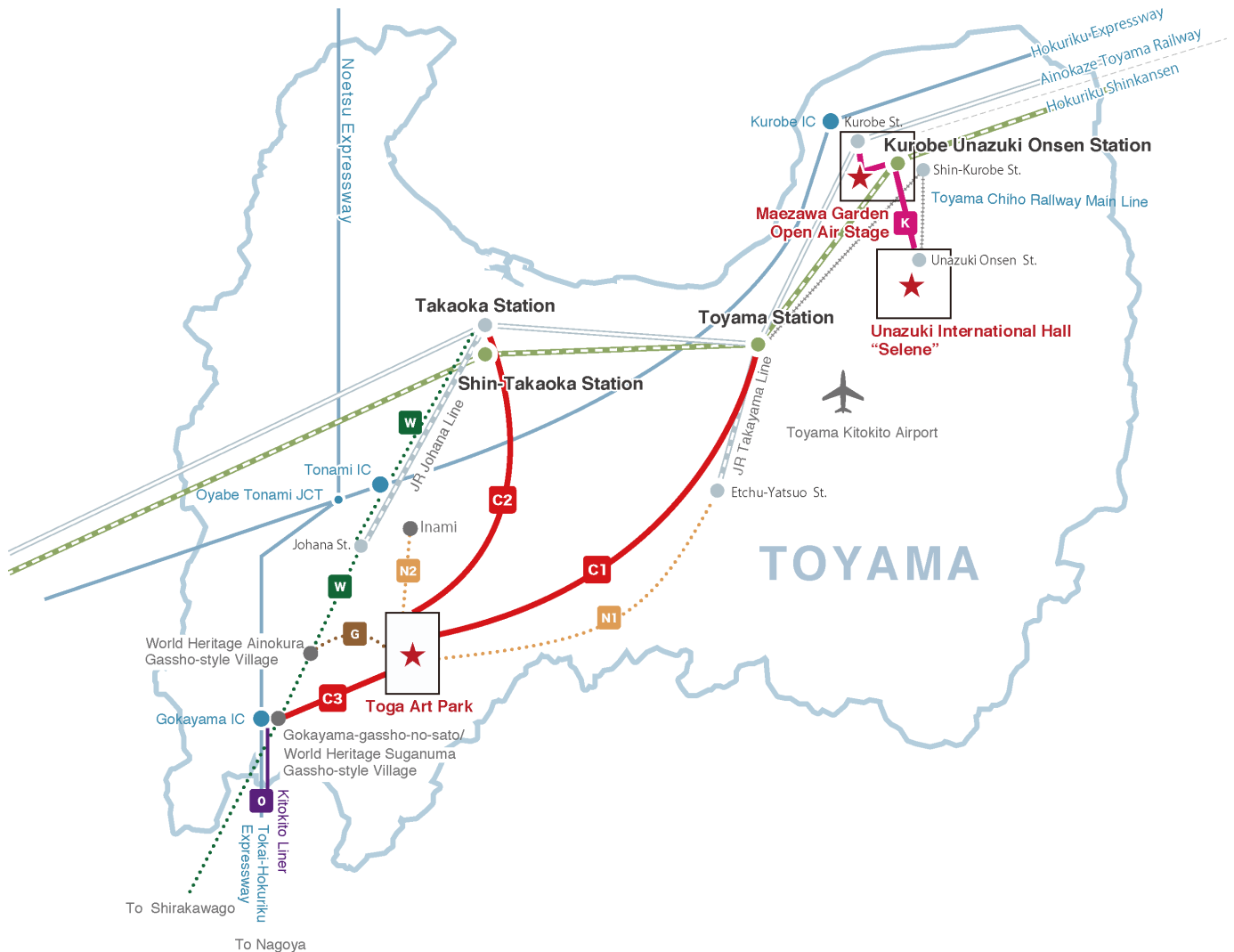

TRANSPORTATION TO TOGA

[To first-time visitors]

- There are only two public city buses per day running to Toga from Etchu-Yatsuo St./Inami St. Therefore, we recommend taking the charter buses that are scheduled in conjunction with the performances.
- There are relatively few accommodations in Toga, so make your reservation early.
- There are no convenience stores or shops. Food and merchandise can be purchased at the Gurume-kan (food court).
- There are no ATMs in the village, so we suggest you bring a fair amount of cash with you. Some of the shops/restaurants in Gurume-kan accept credit cards.
- There are many insects during the summer. We suggest that you bring insect repellent and proper attire for protection.
- Temperature can drop below 10 degrees Celsius in the morning and evenings. Be sure to bring warm clothes with you.

[C] CHARTER BUSES

Charter buses will run between the main stations and Toga Art Park, in conjunction with the performance schedule. Reservations can be made up until 3 days prior to your trip.

- **[C1] Toyama Charter Bus** [Price: 500 yen, reservation required]

Outbound: Toyama Station (South exit) →Toga Art Park

Inbound: Toga Art Park →Toyama Station (South exit)

- **[C2] Takaoka Charter Bus** [Price: 500 yen, reservation required]

Outbound: Takaoka Station (Zuiryu-ji exit) →Shin-Takaoka Station (South exit) →Toga Art Park

Inbound: Toga Art Park →Shin-Takaoka Station (South exit) →Takaoka Station (Zuiryu-ji exit)

- **[C3] Gokayama Gassho-no-sato Charter Bus** [Price: 300 yen, reservation required]

—Linked with the Kitokito Liners departing from Nagoya Station*

Outbound: Gokayama Gassho-no-sato →Toga Art Park

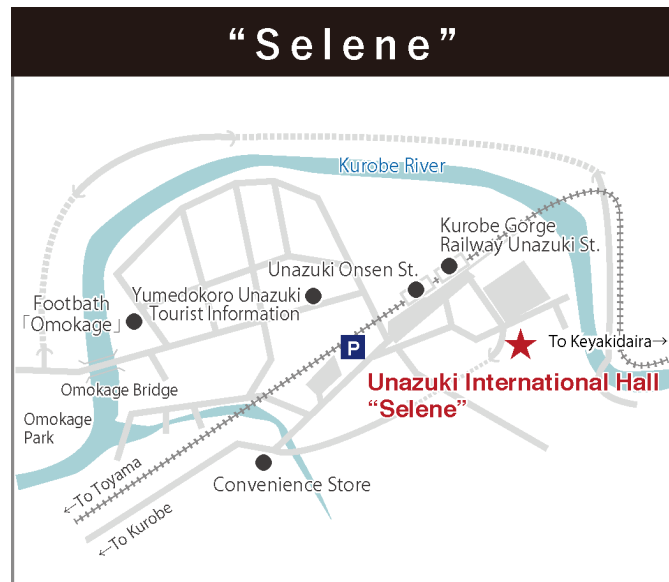
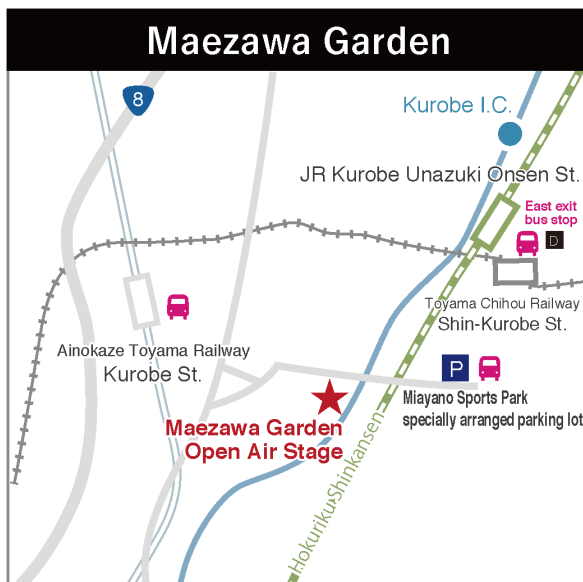
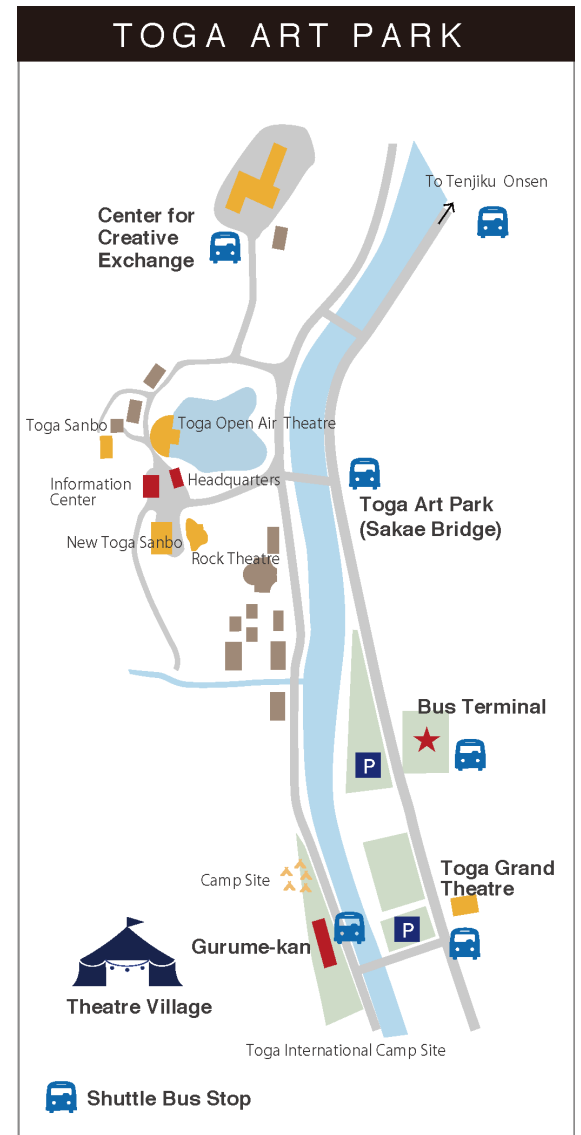

How to make reservations for Transportation, Accommodation, and Breakfast

Official transportation, accommodation, and breakfast reservations begin on June 30 (Sun.) at 9:30 am

1. Book Your Theatre Tickets

Fee: 2,000 yen/performance

Talk shows, symposiums and observation of workshops are free; however, reservation is required.

Take note of your “ticket reservation number” that you will receive once you make your reservation.

You will need this number when booking your accommodation and buses.

2. Book Your Accommodation, Bus and Breakfast

You will be asked to give the names of all members staying at the accommodation and/or boarding the bus service.

3. Payment

Payments for accommodation and breakfast can be made by credit card (online reservations only), convenience store payment, or by bank transfer. If the payment is not made in time, your reservations may be cancelled.

Payments for the charter bus service can be made by cash when boarding the bus.

4. Confirm the Booking

Those making reservations online will receive a confirmation e-mail. Those making reservations over the phone will receive a confirmation letter by post. Be sure to verify the contents.

5. To Cancel or Change Your Booking

Please let us know if you would like to add/cancel/change any of your theatre tickets, accommodation, bus or breakfast reservations by phone or e-mail. A cancellation fee will occur if the accommodation reservation is cancelled within four days prior to the check-in date.
